FACE-TO-FACE BOARD AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE STRATEGIC PLANNING SESSION TO

BE HELD OVER THREE DAYS (30 September – 02 October 2025)

# 1. BACKGROUND

The National Electronic Media Institute of South Africa (NEMISA) is a training institute with a focus on creative media and digital skills. NEMISA derives its mandate from the Department of Communications and Digital Technologies (DCDT).

NEMISA was established as a non-profit institute for education in terms of the Companies Act (1973) and is listed as a Schedule 3A public entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act (1999).

## 2. SCOPE OF WORK

NEMISA seeks to appoint a service provider to facilitate a Strategic Planning Session for the Board. The role of the strategic planning facilitator is to provide technical assistance and facilitation to support discussions and manage the programme for the sessions. The requirements include:

- The facilitator should have a great understanding of the rapidly developing digital environment to which NEMISA has to respond to regarding digital skills development.
- Provision of advice to the Board on the strategic planning process to be followed.
- Apply tested methodologies successfully used in the strategic planning process for stateowned entities.
- Facilitation of the Strategic Planning Session, including breakaway and plenary sessions.
- Preparation of the Strategic Planning Report in line with NEMISA's requirements and timelines.
- Development of an Annual Performance Plan (APP) and establishing SMART goals and output indicators with defined time frames, and assist in the development of an action plan to achieve these.
- Re-emphasising the strategic intent of the Institute.
- Provide orchestration of the discussions per topic in the session and summarise with clear next steps (Development of an action log for NEMISA Board).
- Capture notes and input from all participants at the Strategic Planning Session.

- A Strategic Planning Session Report to be delivered within the agreed time after the Strategic Planning Session. The report must include a detailed analysis of the discussions held and also clearly capturing the strategic direction on each of the discussed topics or strategic focus areas.
- Consider the current Annual Performance Plan and Action Plan when drafting the new Annual Performance Plan and Action Plan.
- 2026/27 Draft Annual Performance Plan
- 2026/27 Draft Action Plan including cost implications or estimated budgets, objectives, and activities identified at the strategic planning session to be delivered within two weeks after the Strategic Planning Session.
- Strategic Planning Session material (i.e., approach)

The facilitation service is required for 3 working days. The date of the Strategic Planning Session is 30 September – 02 October 2025. An additional one day is required for a preparatory meeting with the Board Chairperson, the Executive, and the Company Secretary.
