REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR APPOINTMENT OF A TRAVEL AGENCY(S) TO RENDER TRAVEL, ACCOMMODATION, CONFERENCE, AND VENUE HIRE MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO NEMISA FOR 36 MONTHS.

1. INTRODUCTION

The National Electronic Media Institute of South Africa (NEMISA) was established as a non-profit institute for education in terms of the Companies Act (1973) and is listed as a schedule 3A public entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act (1999). NEMISA derives its mandate from the Department of Communications and Digital Technology (DCDT.

NEMISA is an accredited training provider with the Media, Information, and Communication Technologies Sector Education and Training Authority (MICT SETA) in creative media and digital skills.

- 2. PURPOSE OF THIS REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)
- The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to solicit proposals from potential bidder(s) for the provision of travel management services to NEMISA
- This RFQ document details and incorporates, as far as possible, the tasks and responsibilities of the potential bidder required by Nemisa for the provision of travel management services to NEMISA
- This RFQ does not constitute an offer to do business with Nemisa but merely serves as an invitation to the bidder(s) to facilitate a requirements-based decision process.
- NEMISA requires a comprehensive travel and accommodation management service on behalf of the Institution for all NEMISA officials for business/official purposes.
- 1.1 The services required include the provision of:
 - a) Air Travel (Domestic and International)
 - b) Accommodation
 - c) Car Rental
 - d) Booking of shuttle services (including the Gautrain)
 - e) Conferencing, venues, and related facilities and services as may be specified by NEMISA officials.
 - 1.2. The travel agency will be expected to ensure that such travel services are rendered in the most cost-effective manner that is operationally efficient to support the achievement of the Institution's mandate. The Travel Agency must always ensure practical means of travel and accommodation based on NEMISA's Policies, National
- Treasury Instruction Note NO. 03 OF 2016/2017 on Cost Containment for Travel and National Travel Policy Framework (NTPF).
 - 1.3. In cases where the trip includes both air and road travel, Travel Agency must select the mode and combination thereof that is the most cost-effective, taking into account the cost of the trip, time consumed, and productivity.
 - 1.4. The Travel Agency must compare various airline fares, accommodation establishment rates, and car rental rates before confirming a booking, maintaining the principles of competitiveness and cost-effectiveness in supporting the Institution's sustainability.
 - 1.5. Any travel amendments must be in line with NEMISA's Policies, National Treasury Instruction Note NO. 03 OF 2016/2017 on Cost Containment for Travel and National Travel Policy Framework (NTPF).
 - 1.6. The Travel Agency must through their Travel Management System provide a monthly report to NEMISA relating monthly cost containment information specifically relating to paragraph 5 on the Treasury Instruction Note.
 - 1.7. The Travel Agency should be a fully accredited member of IATA and ASATA with access to an acceptable travel database e.g., AMADEUS and GALILEO to ensure the effective and efficient provision of travel, accommodation, and vehicle rental management service
 - 2. SCOPE OF WORK
 - 2.1. NEMISA requirement for domestic or international travel and accommodation which covers the following in total or in part countrywide and worldwide:
- 2.1.1 Air Travel
 - a) Source quotations for air travel based on the travel requests received from NEMISA
 - b) Upon receipt of an order from NEMISA the Travel Agency should secure, confirm bookings and execute payment by preagreed means of all air travel bookings or as discussed and agreed in the SLA.
 - c) Issue and forward travel documentation (relevant travel itineraries and flight e-tickets to

the travel booker at the NEMISA, copying the traveller).

- d) Negotiating discounts on standard tariffs for air travel with all available airline companies.
- e) Negotiating discounts in travel rands or credits on accumulated expenditure for air travel with all available airline companies/ensure the government negotiated corporate rates and fares where applicable or as prescribed by National Treasury from time to time.
- f) The Travel Agency must ensure that all bookings to be made in Make bookings in line with the NEMISA Policies and any amendments must be approved by NEMISA

2.1.2. Vehicle Rental

- a) Upon receipt of an order number from the NEMISA, the Travel Management Agency must confirm bookings and execute payment by pre-agreed means of bookings or as discussed and agreed in the SLA,
- b) Source quotations from vehicle rental suppliers and/or drivers/shuttle services based on travel requests received from the NEMISA:
- c) Booking vehicles in line with car rental companies and amending any confirmed bookings if necessary and in line with NEMISA's Policies and subject to approval of any amendments by NEMISA,
 - d) Negotiating discounts on standard tariffs or reduced tariffs with all available companies where possible/negotiating the government negotiated corporate rates and fares where applicable or as prescribed by National Treasury from time to time.
 - e) The Travel Agency must ensure that all bookings to be made in Make bookings in line with the Nemisa Policies

2.1.3. Shuttle Service

a) Booking transport, including a driver, with shuttle service/car rental companies and amending if necessary.

2.1.4. Accommodation

- a) Source and submit quotations from various accommodation service providers (hotels, guest houses, etc. in line with the NEMISA's Policies) based on the travel request received from the NEMISA per specified date and location.
- b) Upon receipt of an order from the NEMISA, confirm bookings and issue booking confirmation vouchers to the relevant person at NEMISA and execute payment by pre- agreed means of all accommodation needs or as discussed and agreed in the SLA,
- c) Booking amendments on accommodation including resolving concerns with any hotel group, private hotel, guest house, or other available concerns, e.g., guest house or boarding house, where such a requirement is referred to the Travel Agent must be approved by NEMISA before implementation.
- d) Negotiating discounts on standard tariffs with all available accommodation service providers on behalf of NEMISA and reports efforts made on this periodically.
- e) The Travel Agency must ensure that all bookings to be made in Make bookings in line with the Nemisa Policies

2.1.5. Conferencing, venue, and related facilities

- a) Sourcing venues for conferences/seminars/related facilities based on the request from NEMISA
- b) Upon receipt of an order from NEMISA, the Travel Agency to confirm bookings and execute payment by pre-agreed means of all air travel bookings or as discussed and agreed in the SLA,
- c) Booking and amending conferencing, venue, and related facilities with service providers including resolving any related concerns/queries as referred to the Travel Agency. Any booking amendments must be approved by NEMISA.
- d) Negotiating discounts on standard tariffs or reduced tariffs with service providers for all available conference venues/seminars/related facilities.
- e) The Travel Agency must ensure that all bookings to be made in Make bookings in line with the Nemisa Policies.

2.1.6. Visa and Passport

a) The Travel Agency should also, where relevant provide service relating to visas, passports, special and/or once-off arrangements, etc. as and when required by NEMISA.

2.1.7. Special Assistance

a) The travel management agency to assist with special requirements such as special meals, excess baggage etc.

- 1.3.4 The Evaluation Committee may recommend that the contract be awarded to the bidder obtaining the highest aggregate mark as determined by 1.3.4 or to a lower scoring bid on justifiable grounds.

1.4 ADJUDICATION OF BID

1.4.1 The relevant award structure will consider the recommendations and make the final award. The successful bidder will usually be the service provider scoring the highest number of points or it may be a lower scoring bid on justifiable grounds or no award at all.
